

Music can serve as a factor of social identification as a necessary component of a person's social and cultural life, that is, it can express a person's belonging to a certain social group, activate a person's emotional state or contribute to his relaxation.[1; 18]

Musical images are born in his imagination, they reveal to the child the characteristics of real things and events in a new way. The child lives in that bright world, born under the influence of music. Therefore, a person must learn the basics of music culture, that is, the ability to perceive, feel, understand, and experience a musical image from childhood. According to Sukhomlinsky, it is difficult, almost impossible, to restore

what was lost in childhood. As a rule, a person who does not love and understand music is emotionally undeveloped. He cannot deeply feel and understand the experience of another person. [10; 18-21]

The low level of musical culture in our society, lack of interest in the basics of music classics is the biggest problem of our time. As a result, schoolchildren and even students are not sufficiently familiar with classical art, museum collections, they have no idea about concerts where you can hear the "live" sounds of such music. According to sociological surveys, the main types of free time for Russian children and youth are computer games, watching TV programs and listening to pop music. But the passion for pop music leads to saturation, destroys all aesthetic ideals and needs. Today, a type of person is being formed who is not capable of active, creative perception of real art, who does not experience any deep feelings. When talking about the perception of academic genre music by a listener without professional musical training, researchers are often faced with a lack of understanding and even abandonment of this layer of culture. [7; 3] In order not to create a "chasm" between real, great art and modern entertainment music, our country should teach children creatively from kindergarten to the last grade of school. teachers should make great efforts to have it in their hands. can teach not only to love and understand music, especially classical music, but also to understand it correctly and understand its language.

All this makes the lesson interesting, it can be said exciting, affects the emotions of schoolchildren more, but nothing in the lesson can replace "live" music - the performance of works on the teacher's instrument his voice, his exciting words, instilling love for beauty in children's hearts, teaching them to correctly perceive the musical image and its mood.

Music directly affects the student's emotions and mind, shapes his moral character. Works with different emotional and figurative content encourage children to empathize. Perception of musical works about Mother Nature awakens feelings of love for the Motherland, Russian people and classical music, and arouses feelings of pride, respect and love for one's people, artistic heritage. Solving the problems of musical education for schoolchildren requires the teacher to choose optimal methods based on the characteristics of musical activity and the abilities of students. Success accompanies a teacher who has a creative approach to business, including not only an active part of the class, but also students with low initiative. The teacher awakens interest in music in children, enriches their inner world, and awakens a feeling of joy and satisfaction in their hearts.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSIONS

Collective actions of the class help to solve educational problems - this is singing, games, musical and rhythmic actions, playing children's musical instruments - children are united by common actions that require the common efforts and common experiences of all participants. moments. creating a favorable ground for general development. Different types of activities, their alternation, tasks require children's attention, good reaction, organization - this is singing, dancing, the simultaneous beginning and end of accompaniment on children's musical instruments, the ability to obey music, curbing children's natural instincts. rush, overtake - all this educates the child's feelings of will, responsibility, friendship, and forms the moral qualities of the student's personality.

All activities in a music lesson (perception, singing, musical and rhythmic movements, playing children's musical instruments) are closely related to mental processes, that is, they require attention, observation, quick thinking. Creative tasks are of great importance, that is, problem-searching situations that require high mental activity: children improvise, create their own versions of the melody, accompaniment, rhythmic patterns for a certain text, dance movements, every game in the game. describes what character or story, with the help of expressive movements, facial expressions, gestures, when children stop being shy, they become more relaxed.

The meaning of teaching music at school is that while learning music, children are in the process of active creative activity. They themselves sing and play, learn not only to perceive the beauty of musical works, but also to create it "with their own

hands". The active nature of music lessons teaches you to better see the life around you and understand your own spiritual world. Singing in a choir, playing in a children's musical instrument orchestra forms in children a sense of responsibility for the group they are a part of. Asafiyev B.V. wrote: "A person who experiences the joy of creativity in the smallest degree deepens his life experience, differs in his psychological structure from a person who only imitates the actions of others." It should also not be forgotten that music lessons help improve children's health: singing develops the vocal apparatus, strengthens the vocal cords, helps develop hearing and voice coordination, correct breathing (short breathing and long exhalation) develops; musical-rhythmic movements improve children's posture, develop coordination of movements, quick reaction to changes in tempo or dynamics in music.

CONCLUSION

Educators in many countries are still debating whether to teach music to all children or only to gifted children. Russian pedagogy answers this question as follows: music as a profession should be taught to children who have excellent musical abilities and a special attraction to music.
